Type 2 is required for 1924-26-28-30-31-32-33-34-36-38-39-40-42-54-56-58-60-62-63-64-66-71-73-85-93-95/2003 Lakeport, plus 11100-10-12-21-22-23-25-27-29 Lakespray.

Non-standard numbers are not allowed.

Standard History

Original: Original construction provided three types of house numbers that have all deteriorated with time. Lack of standards has led to inconsistency. Public safety regulations require a readable house number; consistency in location/appearance is desirable to emergency and delivery personnel.

06/14/05: Required Phase 1 construction to be consistent with Phase 2 construction. Provided product specifications to maintain visual harmony within the Cluster.

06/08/10: Updated format for standards continuity. Required house numbers above garage or carport for consistency in the case that house number is not directly lit to help emergency vehicles find a specific address.
